

## 7.2.1 – Describe at least two institutional best practices

### 1. Driving License Camp:

Objective: As the students studying in the college are from the age group 17-25, they used two wheelers as well as four wheelers for the conveyance, but most of them are not sincere about driving license. In case of any road accident without a driving license, they have to face many problems. The camp was organized for DL in the college campus with the help of the road transport department of Chhattisgarh Surajpur district to make students aware about traffic rules. The students have been provided a facility to apply for the learning driving license in the college campus with the help of RTO in the camp.

### 2. To start Corona Warrior Initiative

Objective: In the time of Covid-19 pandemic NSS volunteers of the college have taken initiative to break the covid-19 chain. with coordination of district Administration and police department they ran a campaign to make people aware about covid-19 distributed masks and performed duty to maintain social distance.

### 3. Legal aid awareness programme

Objective: Legal aid awareness program is very important for empowerment of individuals regarding issues involving the law for this purpose, the college organizes legal aid awareness programme in which experts from district legal service authority deliver lectures. This lecture was very useful to college students to enhance their legal awareness.

### 4. CCTV installation in new science building

Objective: CCTV cameras in a public place enhance the safety of the area so for this purpose CCTV cameras have been installed to improve safety of the college premises.

## **5. Fit India movement**

Objective: fit India movement was introduced on the occasion of National sports day and it was telecasted in the college in which students were motivated for better and healthy livelihood.

## **6. Fit India cyclothon 2020 under fit India movement**

Objective: fit India cyclothon 2020 were conducted in which college students participated and started a cycle rally with faculties at Surajpur City to motivate the people of Surajpur towards awareness about healthy livelihood.

## **7. Girl students trained for self-defense.**

Objective: Due to incidents of molestation an environment of fear is being spread day by day. To cope up with the situation, the college organized a training camp for the girl students of the college under the banner of NSS unit with collaboration of district legal service authority and police administration. During the training, students were trained to defend themselves from molesters, so that their confidence level may grow up.

## **8. Plantation for greenery and eco friendly campus**

Objective: Objectives of the Practice: The college has a huge campus of 10.567 hec. of land. Plantation has been done in the campus for green and clean campus, as a result making greenery and creating a pollution free environment in the college campus. It has also been resolved to make it plastic free to develop it as an ideal campus. In order to make the college campus plastic free, about 100 students (Volunteers) of the college cleaned the campus from time to time. Every week 50 volunteers and other students, together collect the scattered plastic Gutka, Tobacco, Pouches, carry bags, chips packets and other plastic waste from the campus and hand it over to the Municipal Corporation's garbage cast.
